### **Some Frequently Asked Questions:**

### What time does supervision begin and end?

Morning supervision begins at 8:15 am and ends at 8:25. At 8:15, parents are encouraged to "Kiss & Go" (kiss your child goodbye and ride/walk/drive away) in order to relieve parking lot congestion. We ask that bikes and scooters are parked safely at our bike rack and not ridden on the school grounds after 8:00am or before 3:00pm. Please walk your bike/scooter if you arrive after 8:00 or before 3:00. Also note that dogs are not permitted on school property (Colwood Bylaw 1533). Please arrange to have your child in the care of a parent/guardian outside of school supervision times. It is an expectation of the school that all students are dismissed at 2:38 pm to a waiting parent/guardian.

Kindergarten children must be dropped off and picked up by an adult outside of the Kindergarten classroom. Children will only be released into the care of an adult who is on the pick-up list.

# How does student drop off and pick-up work? Traffic and Parking

As with most schools, traffic is challenging during drop-off and pick-up times. Community representatives, District Staff, PAC, RCMP and school administration have worked together over the years to create plans to ensure student safety. We need support from all. Key safety points include:

- 1. The school zone speed limits are posted on Wishart Road and the RCMP monitor the school zone regularly.
- 2. The staff parking lot is located at the back of the school and is reserved for staff. Please do not use this as a drop-off and pick-up zone or to park.
- 3. Parking at the front of the school is limited. If you can, please park in the parking lot on Sooke Road (not the Westshore School lot) or along roads close to the school and walk your child onto the school property. And if possible, walk from home, should you live close by.
- 4. Should you use our school parking, use the designated parking spaces. Please note that parking along the yellow curbs is impeding the fire lane and is prohibited by the Colwood Fire Department. We need to ensure that the fire lane and emergency parking area is free for emergency responders and their vehicles.

- 5. Please note that the accessible parking space in front of the school is reserved for families who require this for dropping off and picking up their children.
- 6. Please drop off and pick up promptly. remember our encouragement to "Kiss & Go"

### What do I do if my child will be late or absent from school?

### What if my child arrives late, leaves early, or has an appointment during the day?

When you arrive, please ensure that your student checks in with the front office. We ask that you please do your very best to be on time in the morning. For any late arrivals or early pickups, please email the Colwood attendance line (mandatory) and your child's classroom teacher.

# What if I arrive early at afternoon pickup, can my children play on the playground equipment?

We ask that you do not have your children in any of our outdoor play or classroom areas, as classes access these areas between 8:30 and 2:38.

### What should I do if our family is away at the beginning of the school year?
