Please remember to slow down when driving on Colwood School property. We have small children both in kindergarten and during our Strong Start morning programs.

We have noticed people parking in the bus lane, fire lane and in front of the crosswalk. This is not allowed as it blocks the road when a bus needs to get through. Several times when cars are parked in the fire lane near the playground, our district bus has had to wait for the person(s) to return to vehicles to move them. Parking and obstructing the view of the crosswalk is dangerous for our students and staff after school. Please drop off or pick up and keep moving to avoid this dangerous problem.
