Everything you need to know about the basketball jamboree

Basketball Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the Sooke District Elementary Basketball Jamborees. We want to thank Belmont Basketball and Westshore Basketball for helping organize and run this event!



Please remember:

- Teams can enter the school at 3:35p.m. School will be clearing out at Belmont when most people arrive. Parking will be a challenge. Parking will be in the lower parking lots at Goudy Field. You can drop off players at the front doors nearest the gymnasium and then find parking in the lower lots.
- 2) NEW THIS YEAR: Players should meet their coaches at their team table with their school's name on it in the foyer outside the gymnasium.
- 3) Team tables be a 'home base' for teams between games in the foyer.
- 4) The gym will open for players at 3:40pm. There will be seating in the bleachers and on chairs along the sidelines. Please do not block doors while watching games. Washroom facilities are available in the gym. Please do not wander the school or upper floors.
- Scoreboards will display the score for each game and all game times will be controlled by a central clock.
- 6) Schedules will be posted around the gym and school. The gym will be divided into three courts.
- 7) There will be a concession. Limited ice will be available for injuries.
- 8) **No open drinks are allowed onto the gym floor.** This includes lid-less coffee cups and any non-resealable bottles or containers. Please understand that we are guests of Belmont and need to respect the rules of their gym.
- 9) Scorekeepers and referees have volunteered their time to help make this event a success. Please show your appreciation by respecting all jamboree volunteers.
